The result shows the water softener to be one of the very highest energy-saving and best ‘green’ technology appliances that a homeowner can own.

9:45 am – 10:45 am	<u>Seminar #2 - Soft Water Benefits #2.</u> One hour presentation by <i>Joe Harrison, on behalf of the Water Quality Association</i> , will discuss three more industry studies and results including: WQRF sponsored ongoing <u>“Investigation of the Enhancement of Performance of Laundry Detergents, Dishwashing Detergents, and Fabric Softeners by the Use of Soft Water”</u> , which finding show water hardness is as significant as detergent dosages, and water temperature in laundry and dishwashing cleaning.
